Clubhouse Kids Enrollment Plan AM/PM Coverage Cutoff Times Explained

A tremendous advantage of Clubhouse Kids when compared to other in-school-located child care companies is our extended coverage times on "half-day school days" and "no-school school days", at no additional cost for kids in our regular attendance enrollment plans.

A child enrolled in After School Care ONLY can arrive at school on a no-school school-day or on a delayed opening day (on their normally attending day of the week) as early as 9:00am-sharp and can remain in care as late as 6:30pm <u>at no additional cost</u>.

A child enrolled in Before School Care ONLY can remain in care on a no-school school-day or early dismissal day (on their normally attending day of the week) until 3:00pm-sharp at no additional cost.

By comparison, any other child care company in the area that offers similar care at no additional cost uses cutoff times of 12:00pm for both AM enrolled and PM enrolled children.

Additionally, the YMCA only offers care on no-school school days at an additional cost of \$35 per child per day, with **nothing covered** without the additional cost. This <u>really</u> adds up over the school year, averaging to about \$100 per child <u>per month</u> in extra fees. Several other companies have similar policies.

We have never heard of another child care company offering the coverage cutoff times that we offer.

However, please remember that the cutoff times are "sharp". In other words, if a child arrives for care only a few minutes early, or remains only a few minutes late, the corresponding drop-in fee (typically \$15 or \$20 per child per day) will be charged to the account.
